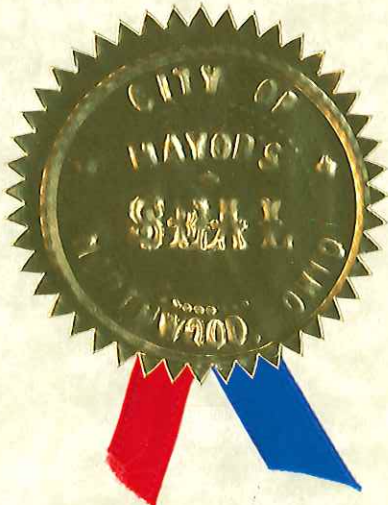
Whereas, Dispatcher Espinosa received this Award for a call she received on September 17, 2015 involving a woman in distress at the Bob Evans Restaurant with her family.
