

# “ARE YOU O.K.?”

“ARE YOU O.K.?” is a computerized system that will automatically check on your safety and security seven days a week. It’s a program designed to give the senior citizen or homebound person a greater feeling of security by providing them with a daily telephone check seven days a week.

A computer will make the call. When answered, a recorded voice will let the senior citizen or homebound person know this is their daily call. If everything is okay, no words need be spoken by the senior citizen or homebound. If not answered, the computer will call back within an hour. If not answered a second time, a neighbor or key holder will be contacted. If they know nothing of your whereabouts, a police vehicle will be dispatched.

## PROCEDURE:

1. Submit Interest Form.
2. A police department representative will call you for a convenient appointment.
3. An interview form will be filled out noting emergency notification, next of kin, key holders, clergy, and other pertinent information.
4. Information from this form will be entered into the computer.
5. A letter welcoming you to the “ARE YOU O.K.?” program will be sent giving you a service number.
6. Calls will then begin.
