ORDINANCE 2020-38

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Finance Director of the City of Northwood has reviewed October expenditures and finds the need to make adjustments to appropriations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to increase Supplemental Appropriations in the General Fund totaling \$18,250 as follows:

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to increase Supplemental Appropriations in the Streets Fund totaling \$19,200 as follows:

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and State of Ohio.
