ORDINANCE 2020-43

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH MEDICAL MUTUAL FOR HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, enrollment for Health Insurance Benefits for Northwood City employees is necessary for January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City Administrator is authorized to enter into a renewal agreement as summarized on Exhibit (A) attached, beginning January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021, with Medical Mutual for healthcare insurance for Northwood City employees.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure to insure that the health needs of the employees are met, and therefore promote the health, safety and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by City Council.


