RESOLUTION 2021-04

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, OHIO TO BE A SECOND AMENDMENT SANCTUARY CITY.

WHEREAS, the Right of the People to keep and Bear Arms is affirmed and protected as an Individual Right under the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution and expressly forbidden to be Infringed in any way, and;

WHEREAS, the right of the people to Keep and Bear arms is protected and guaranteed under the Constitution of the State of Ohio, Article 1, Section 4, and;

WHEREAS, the Right of the People to Keep and Bear Arms for their defense and security is regarded as an inalienable Right by the People of the City of Northwood, Ohio, and;

WHEREAS, the Northwood, Ohio City Council, has been elected to represent the People of Northwood, Ohio and being duly sworn be their Oath of Office to uphold the United States Constitution and the Constitution of the State of Ohio, and;

WHEREAS, the citizens of Northwood are opposed to any legislation considered by the Ohio State Legislature, Governor, the United States congress or the President of the United States that would infringe upon the right to keep and bear arms and/or would ban the possession and use of any firearm, magazines, ammunition or accessories now employed by individual citizens of Northwood, Ohio for defense and security or would require a firearms owner ID card, registration of person or firearm or tax the possession of firearms or ammunition within Northwood, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. that the Northwood City Council does hereby oppose the enactment of any legislation or executive action that would infringe upon the rights of the People to Keep and Bear Arms and consider such laws or directives to be unconstitutional and beyond lawful governmental authority.

SECTION 2. the People of Northwood, Ohio, affirm support of the Northwood Police Department and all City Staff and Employees and direct such, to refuse support and decline to assist any agency attempting to enforce any of the above mentioned restrictions, without a duly sworn warrant for primary criminal activity other than any unconstitutional laws or executive actions listed, unless an immediate threat to life exists.

SECTION 3. that the Northwood City Council will not appropriate any funds for the enforcement of unconstitutional laws or executive actions against the people of Northwood, Ohio.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.




