## ORDINANCE 2016-17

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARTICIPATION BY THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD IN THE WOOD COUNTY PARK DISTRICT GRANT PROGRAM AND ALLOWING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS,** The City of Northwood owns and operates numerous recreation facilities used by the community; and

**WHEREAS,** a number of Northwood High School students and a staff member are desirous of improving the use of said facilities by applying for four separate grants from the Wood County Park District's Local Park Improvement Grant 2016 Program.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City of Northwood approves the filing of applications for said grants in various amounts from the Wood County Park District's Local Park Improvement Grant 2016 and authorizes the City Administrator to sign the necessary paperwork.

**SECTION 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

**SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the deadline for 2016 park improvement grant application submittal(s) is June 30, 2016. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.






