ORDINANCE 2016-20

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, OHIO AND THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, OHIO LABOR COUNCIL, INC. (SERGEANTS), EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2016 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2019; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Northwood has negotiated with the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (Sergeants) and entered into a Tentative Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Northwood is hereby authorized to enter into a written agreement between the City of Northwood, Ohio and the Fraternal Order of Police Association (Sergeants) more fully described in Exhibit A attached hereto.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the reason that the continued agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (Sergeants), is necessary in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.


