ORDINANCE 2016-27

ORDINANCE APPROVING THE JOB DESCRIPTION FOR THE POLICE OFFICER (SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT) ASSIGNED AS THE "SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER" FOR THE NORTHWOOD LOCAL SCHOOLS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the School Resource Officer is a newly created position within the City Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the job responsibilities of the School Resource Officer are approved as outlined in Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure because updating job descriptions is necessary to promote the health, safety and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.
