Ordinance No. 2016-28

Passed August 25, 2016

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS REQUIRED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvement to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Northwood, Ohio is planning to make capital improvements to the Tracy Road and Wales Road Intersection which will consist of widening the intersection for a turn lane.

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered a priority for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

SECTION 2. That the City Administrator is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining the financial assistance.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is that the prompt passage of this ordinance is necessary so that the application can be submitted to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for Issue I project funds by the posted deadline for 2017 projects thereby protecting the health, safety and welfare of our citizens.
