ORDINANCE 2016-31

ORDINANCE AMENDING N.C.O. 206.01(f), TITLED PUBLIC MEETINGS – “POSTS”; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That the N.C.O. 206.01(f), titled “Post” shall read as follows:

206.01 DEFINITIONS

“Post” means to post in an area accessible to the public during the usual business hours at the office of the Clerk and at the following locations: The Municipal Administration Building and at the Northwood Police Department.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure because notification to the public of Ordinances is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.
