ORDINANCE 2016-5

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO ENTER INTO THE OWENS COMMUNITY COLLEGE CENTER FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CONSORTIUM MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Northwood Police Department desires to enter into an Agreement for training of sworn officers and communication officers with Owens Community College;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. That the Northwood Chief of Police is hereby authorized to sign the Owens College Center for Law Enforcement and Professional Development Training Consortium Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and to continue each year thereafter if the Chief of Police desires to participate in the Training Consortium.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or related to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure because continued law enforcement training benefits the Police Department and therefore is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of our citizens.
