**AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE POND**

*Feb 25, 2016*

**AT RANGER PARK AS "MARK A. STONER POND".**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Northwood by Ordinance 2007-25 dedicated for park purposes a city owned parcel of land at 3201 Curtice Road to be known as RANGER PARK; and

**WHEREAS**, the City established rules and regulations for the use of RANGER PARK by Ordinance 2008-17; and

**WHEREAS**, within the boundaries of said Ranger Park is a body of water approximating five (5) acres in size; and

**WHEREAS**, Mark A. Stoner while the Mayor of the City of Northwood was instrumental in the creation of Ranger Park; and

**WHEREAS**, Mark A. Stoner served as Mayor of Northwood for sixteen (16) years between 1999 and 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, prior to serving as Mayor, Mark A. Stoner served seven (7) years on City Council from 1993 through 1998 and served on the City Planning Commission the prior four (4) years; and

**WHEREAS**, Mark A. Stoner retired from public office at the end of 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, it is appropriate that individuals making significant contributions to our community be honored in a meaningful way.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDNED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO THAT:**

**Section 1.** That the public pond located within Ranger Park be named "**MARK STONER POND**".

**SECTION 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

**SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure to insure that the health needs of the employees are met, and therefore promote the health, safety and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.
