## ORDINANCE 2017-17

### (AS AMENDED)

#### ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF NON-UNION MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** That the compensation for non-union management personnel,  
effective July 1, 2017, and shall be as follows:

<i>[Effective August 1, 2017]</i>	\$ 50,618.70
Planning, Zoning Coordinator	\$ 51,046
Police Captain	\$ 75,178
City Law Director	\$ 29,221
City Prosecutor	\$ 17,346

**SECTION 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning  
or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the  
Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that  
resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance  
with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

**SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance constitutes as emergency measure because  
updating the Compensation of non-union management personnel is necessary for the  
immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of our citizens. This  
ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council.




