ORDINANCE 2017-41

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND CITY FISCAL OFFICER TO "WRITE OFF" UNCOLLECTABLE BAD DEBT ARISING FROM UNPAID INCOME TAXES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Northwood Tax Department has exhausted all efforts to collect and satisfy delinquent income tax accounts in the amount of \$25,039.07 as shown on Exhibit "A" attached; and,

WHEREAS, it is sound fiscal management and generally accepted accounting practice to adjust appropriate Entries to remove these accounts as Bad Debt Expense.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. That the City Administrator and City Fiscal Officer, jointly, are authorized to write off as bad debt expense the \$25,039.07 shown as Exhibit "A" attached hereto on accounts the City has against persons and companies which the City Administrator and City Fiscal Officer have determined to be uncollectable.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be an emergency measure necessary to protect peace, safety, and welfare of our citizens, of the City of Northwood.


