## ORDINANCE 2018-14 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE 1988-33 WHICH CREATED A SIDEWALK COMMISSION AND HEARING BOARD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, The City of Northwood is desirous of amending Section 2 of Ordinance 1988-33 which established a uniform policy in order to determine the priority of sidewalk repairs and sidewalk new construction in accordance with the subdivision rules and regulations, and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has determined that a Sidewalk Commission and Hearing Board is necessary in order to properly administer a fair and uniform method of sidewalk repairs and sidewalk construction,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1:** There is hereby created a Sidewalk Commission and Hearing Board which shall have the power and duty to develop and administer the locations in the City that are in need of sidewalk repair and/or new sidewalk construction. The Sidewalk Commission annually shall make a written report to the City Council on or before April 1 of each year making recommendations for sidewalk repairs and new construction based upon pedestrian and vehicular safety reasons. The priority list shall be subject to the available city funds as appropriated in each calendar year.

**SECTION 2.** This Commission shall consist of five members, namely: The Service Director; The Chairperson of Service; a representative of the Northwood Board of Education; and two citizen members appointed by the Mayor, which citizen members shall be approved by the City Council. These appointments shall be for an indefinite term.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is the prompt establishment of a Sidewalk Commission and Hearing Board is necessary in order to create a uniform policy for sidewalk repairs and construction in the City and in the manner protect the public health, safety and welfare of our citizens.
