ORDINANCE 2018-18

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT WITH WOOD COUNTY, OHIO FOR THE SUBMISSION OF THE COUNTY'S PY2018 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT AND PRESERVATION PROGRAM (CHIP) GRANT APPLICATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Wood County will be submitting a PY2018 CHIP Grant application to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA); and

WHEREAS, ODSA has determined that the City of Northwood is an eligible program participant to partner with Wood County under the PY2018 CHIP PROGRAM, and

WHEREAS, similar to the PY16 CHIP Partnership Grant, Wood County may apply for a \$700,000 PY2018 Grant (\$400,000 for Wood County and \$300,000 for Northwood) for housing assistance to income eligible households; and

WHEREAS, without this partnership arrangement, Wood County would have been eligible for only \$400,000 of CHIP Grant Funds; and

WHEREAS, Wood County has agreed to be the grantee and fiscal agent for the entire PY2018 CHIP Grant; and

WHEREAS, Wood County has agreed to retain and track the PY2018 CHIP Program Income for future housing assistance to income eligible households in both City of Northwood and Wood County CHIP Service Area; and

WHEREAS, Northwood agrees with the stipulations of the Program Partnership Agreement delineated in the attached CHIP Program Partnership Agreement between the City of Northwood and Wood County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a partnership agreement with Wood County for the submission of Wood County's PY2018 CHIP Application due on May 4, 2018.

SECTION 2. Partnering with the County will enable Northwood and Wood County to apply for \$700,000 of CHIP Grant Funds.

SECTION 3. Wood County has agreed to be the Grantee for this program and be responsible for the administration and implementation of the PY2018 CHIP Grant.

SECTION 4. Wood County will be the fiscal agent for the entire grant and will be responsible for the prerequisite fund drawdowns, status and monitoring reports.

SECTION 5. Wood County will retain, track and administer the CHIP Program Income and use it to assist other eligible households in both City of Northwood and Wood County CHIP Service Area.

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SECTION 6. Northwood agrees to enter into the attached Partnership Agreement with Wood County for the County's PY2018 CHIP Grant and agrees to the stipulations including therein.

SECTION 7. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this council and any of its subcommittees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 122.22 of the Ohio Revised Code of Ohio and that the reading and adoption of this Ordinance complies with the provisions of Article III, Section 3.11 of the City Charter.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare. The reason for the emergency is that this joint City and County CHIP Application is due to the State of Ohio on May 4, 2018.






