ORDINANCE 2018-19

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Finance & Revenue Director has reviewed 2018 Appropriation Accounts and has determined a need to make a Supplemental Appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the unfunded portion of demolition costs of the Tireman Store, Andersons Store and Elder Beerman Store from the Woodville Mall was not included in the 2018 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the contract cost with Midwest Environmental is \$380,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to increase Supplemental Appropriations in the Economic Development and Acquisition Fund totaling \$380,000 as follows:

240 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & ACQUISITION FUND

240-7435-53201 General Improvements \$ 380,000

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and State of Ohio.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of our citizens.


