### ORDINANCE 2018-27

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR BRIDGE INSPECTION PROGRAM SERVICES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, The Ohio Department of Transportation offers a Municipal Bridge Inspection Program to Ohio Municipalities that assists the municipalities with their compliance work required by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Ohio Revised Code (ORC); and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Northwood, Ohio, hereinafter known as the Local Public Agency (LPA), is desirous of making use of this program for bridge inspection purposes as illustrated on Exhibit "A" attached; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Northwood has two bridges on Wales Road (SFN: 8762643 (District 2, Wood County, City of Northwood, WOO-WALES-02.140) and (SFN: 8762651 (District 2, Wood County, City of Northwood, WOO-WALES-02.540) that are affected by this program.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Northwood may have other bridge(s) that are affected by this program.

**WHEREAS**, the LPA has determined the need for the described project being: *Bridge Inspection Services, including but not limited to bridge load rating calculations, scour assessments, bridge inspections, and fracture critical plan development.*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That, being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

**Section 2.** The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

- *The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the cost for Bridge Inspection Program Services requested by the City and agreed to by the State. Eligible Bridge Inspections Services are described in the Consultant's Scope of Services Task Order Contract (Exhibit A).*
- *The LPA agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features which are not included in Exhibit A.*

**Section 3.** The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations.

**Section 4.** The City Administrator of said City of Northwood, Ohio is hereby authorized on behalf of the LPA to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation which are necessary to complete the above described project.

**Section 5.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and State of Ohio.

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**Section 6.** This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure to expedite the highway project and promote public safety.






