## ORDINANCE 2018-28

### ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING INCREASING ESTIMATED RESOURCES AND ADJUSTING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$62,989.11 were received from the State of Ohio for removal of underground storage tanks at the property located at 4433 Woodville Rd., (former AP gas station) and,

WHEREAS, Mannik & Smith has invoiced the city the amount of \$62,989.11 for removal of the tanks, and

WHEREAS, the project was not included in the 2018 Appropriation Budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, OHIO:

**Section 1.** That the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to increase Estimated Resources in Fund 240 Economic Development Fund totaling \$ 63,000 as follows:

240-0500-40506 BUSTER UST Tank Removal Grant \$ 63,000

**Section 2.** That the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to increase Supplemental Appropriations in Fund 240 Economic Development totaling \$63,000 as follows:

240-7435-53201 Real Estate Site Improvements \$ 63,000

**Section 3.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and State of Ohio

**Section 4.** The effective date of this ordinance shall be the earliest date as allowed by law.




