ORDINANCE 2018-38

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-18 AUTHORIZING A FUNDING MODIFICATION OF ORDINANCE 2018-18 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN SAME; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Wood County submitted a PY2018 CHIP Grant application to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA); and

WHEREAS, ODSA has determined that the City of Northwood is an eligible program participant to partner with Wood County under the PY2018 CHIP PROGRAM; and

WHEREAS, Wood County applied for a \$700,000 PY2018 Grant (\$400,000 for Wood County and \$300,000 for Northwood) for housing assistance to income eligible households; and

WHEREAS, Wood County (with Northwood as a partner) has been funded for the Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) Program for PY2018 effective September 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Wood County has been informed that the OSDA has required the County/City expend available Program income in the amount of \$83,000 from the County and \$27,000 from the City as a part of the PY2018 Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The City of Northwood hereby agrees to the modification of the partnership agreement with Wood County and will use available CHIP Program income in the amount of \$27,000 to supplement the OSDA grant.

SECTION 2. The City Finance Director is hereby authorized to deposit the available \$27,000, City-held, CHIP funds into the 2PY2018 CHIP Program.

SECTION 4. Wood County will remain the fiscal agent for the entire grant and will be responsible for the prerequisite fund drawdowns, status and monitoring reports.

SECTION 5. Wood County will retain, track and administer the CHIP Program Income and use it to assist other eligible households in both the City of Northwood and Wood County CHIP Service Area.

SECTION 7. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this council and any of its subcommittees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 122.22 of the Ohio Revised Code of Ohio and that the reading and adoption of this Ordinance complies with the provisions of Article III, Section 3.11 of the City Charter.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare. The reason for the emergency is that this joint City and County CHIP Application is due to the State of Ohio on May 4, 2018.


