ORDINANCE 2019-05

AN ORDINANCE CERTIFYING COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS TO THE WOOD COUNTY AUDITOR FOR THE CUTTING OF WEEDS AND PLACING THOSE ON THE TAX DUPLICATE UNDER PROVISIONS IN OHIO REVISED CODE 731.54; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Northwood City Council passed Ordinance No. 1990-18 requiring the owners of real estate in Northwood, Ohio to cut noxious weeds; and,

WHEREAS, written notification was sent to certain property owners in Northwood, Ohio to cut said noxious weeds; and,

WHEREAS, various property owners failed to cut said weeds as required and have failed to pay invoices sent for the cost of said weed cutting after the September 2018 assessment deadline, therefore this Council hereby determines that such amounts shall be placed upon the tax duplicate in accordance with the provisions in Ohio Revised Code 731.54;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby directs the Finance Director to certify to the Wood County Auditor the parcel numbers and amounts as prepared by the Director of Public Service and Finance Director of the City of Northwood, Ohio.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately as an emergency measure in order that the proper recovery of funds advanced by the City of Northwood is necessary in order to properly protect the health, welfare and safety of its' citizens.
