## ORDINANCE 2019-13

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, OHIO LABOR COUNCIL, INC. (SERGEANTS), EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2019 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2022; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Northwood has negotiated with the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (Sergeants) and entered into a Tentative Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** That the mayor of the City of Northwood is hereby authorized to enter into a written agreement between the City of Northwood, Ohio and the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (Sergeants) more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached.

**SECTION 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

**SECTION 3:** That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure because updating the labor agreement between the City of Northwood and the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (Sergeants) is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of our citizens. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council


