ORDINANCE 2020-10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ROSSFORD AND WOOD COUNTY TO ALLOW FOR COLLABORATION AND SUBMISSION OF PY2020 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT AND PRESERVATION PROGRAM (CHIP) GRANT APPLICATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Wood County will be submitting an PY2020 CHIP Grant application to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA); and

WHEREAS, ODSA has determined that the Cities of Northwood and Rossford are eligible CHIP program participants with Wood County for the PY2020 funding enabling Wood County to apply for \$400,000; Northwood \$300,000 and Rossford \$300,000, for a total grant of \$1,000,000 for housing assistance to income eligible households; and

WHEREAS, without this partnership agreement Wood County would be eligible for only \$400,000 of CHIP Grant Funds; and

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2020 the Wood County Housing Advisory Committee agreed to support the continuation of a partnership arrangement between Wood County and the City of Northwood for the PY2020 Chip Grant Application, agreed the City of Rossford should join the PY2020 CHIP as a partner as well and agreed to include Bowling Green under the County's service area (for HOME funds); and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Northwood and Rossford have reviewed and approved the PY2020 CHIP Partnership arrangements; and

WHEREAS, Wood County agrees to be the Grantee and fiscal agent for the entire PY2020 CHIP Grant and be responsible for the preparation of the PY2020 CHIP Application and the administration of the grant in accordance with the CHIP rules and regulations as required by ODSA; and

WHEREAS, Northwood agrees with the stipulations of the Program Partnership Agreement delineated in the attached CHIP Program Partnership Agreement between the City of Northwood, City of Rossford and Wood County, Ohio,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a partnership agreement with The City of Rossford and Wood County for the submission of PY2020 CHIP Application due June 24, 2020.

SECTION 2. Partnering with the County will enable Northwood, Rossford and Wood County to apply for \$1,000,000 of CHIP Grant Funds.

SECTION 3. Wood County has agreed to be the Grantee for this program and be responsible for the administration and implementation of the PY2020 CHIP Grant.

SECTION 4. Wood County will be the fiscal agent for the entire grant and will be responsible for the prerequisite fund drawdowns, status and monitoring reports.

SECTION 5. Wood County will retain, track and administer the CHIP Program Income and use it to assist other eligible households in Northwood, Rossford and Wood County.

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SECTION 6. Northwood agrees to enter into the attached Partnership Agreement with The City of Rossford and Wood County for the PY2020 CHIP Grant and agrees to the stipulations included therein.

SECTION 7. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare. The reason for the emergency is that this joint City and County CHIP Application is due to the state on June 24, 2020.


