ORDINANCE 2020-15

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 434.03 (B) OF THE NORTHWOOD CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO LIMIT THE MAXIMUM SPEED FOR MOTOR VEHICLES ON PORTIONS OF EAST ANDRUS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Northwood, in effort to promote safety on the streets within the corporation limits, desires to set speed limits on East Andrus,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Northwood Codified Ordinance Section 434.03 shall be amended to reflect the following changes and additions as provided hereinafter. All other Sections of 434.03 shall remain unchanged.

SECTION 434.03 (b) (22) Forty-five miles per hour on East Andrus from Norfolk-Southern Railroad to East Broadway.

SECTION 2. That all other provisions of Section 434.03 of the Northwood Codified Ordinances not hereinbefore amended or modified shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure because setting the proper speed limits is necessary to promote the health, safety and welfare of our citizens.


