ORDINANCE 2020-33

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE WOOD COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW RECORD (ERR) FOR THE PY2020 WOOD COUNTY/NORTHWOOD & ROSSFORD PARTNERSHIP COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT & PRESERVATION (CHIP) PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY, as lead entity and grantee, has been awarded a PY2020 Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) Program grant from the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA), and

WHEREAS, both COUNTY and CITY entered into a partnership for the PY2020 CHIP, executed on June 4, 2020; and both propose to use HOME Housing Program Income in conjunction with the PROJECT, as/when available; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHWOOD, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of Northwood agrees to the terms from the Wood County Commissioners as outlined in "exhibit A" attached hereto.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Northwood and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare.




